Dear Mr Ley, please allow me to introduce myself, I am Hussan Ahktar the owner of Cab Safe Security Solutions based in Birmingham.

I called your office today but unfortunately you was in a meeting and I discussed the reason for my call with Jade Naylor your assistant manager.

I have had an enquiry from a licensed private hire driver based in Exeter who would like to have one of our security screens fitted into his vehicle and would like to place an order very shortly.

Our security screens are manufactured from a 6mm thick transparent polycarbonate material and are purpose built for each individual vehicle.

We believe we have a very unique product for the safety of taxi drivers and would like the opportunity to demonstrate our security screen with a view to seeking approval for installation into private hire vehicles and saloon type hackney carriage licensed taxis within Exeter.

Please be assured we are not requesting any endorsements from your department, the choice of purchasing a security screen is ultimately the drivers choice.
